

GRADUATE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Master of Science: PSYCHOLOGY

Counseling Psychology and School Psychology available only through San Antonio
Weekday/Evening; Marriage and Family Therapy available through Houston
Weekend Degree Program and San Antonio Weekday/Evening

Admission Requirements

1. Application for admission.
2. \$25 non-refundable application fee.
3. Official score report on the Miller Analogies Test (MAT) or Graduate Record Examination (GRE). Test must be taken within the last five years.
4. Official transcripts from all regionally accredited colleges and universities attended. Transcripts must include baccalaureate and higher (if applicable) degrees earned and dates conferred.
5. For applicants with baccalaureate degrees a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.50 (on a 4 point scale) on undergraduate work attempted for the baccalaureate degree OR 3.00 on the last 60 semester hours. For applicants with master's degrees a minimum grade point average of 3.00 on all graduate work attempted.
6. A minimum of 12 undergraduate semester hours in psychology, including one course in statistics, with a minimum grade point average of 3.00.
7. Two letters of recommendation from persons in positions to evaluate applicant's potential academic and career potential.
8. Interview (by invitation only) with psychology faculty.

NOTE: Meeting minimum admission standards does not guarantee admission to the program.

DEADLINES: New students are admitted once a year (to enroll in the fall). All admission materials must be received no later than deadlines specified below:

Counseling Psychology, Marriage and Family Therapy: San Antonio

March 1 - file completion priority deadline.

July 1 - file completion extended deadline.

\$100 non-refundable advanced tuition deposit deadline for admitted students.

School Psychology: San Antonio

July 1 - file completion deadline.

Marriage and Family Therapy: Houston Weekend Degree Program

July 1 - file completion deadline.

International Applicants

In addition to the general and program-specific requirements, international applicants must submit:

1. Certified copies of applicant's educational documents. An official evaluation of these credentials must indicate minimum educational preparation equivalent to a United States baccalaureate degree.
2. A \$50 nonrefundable international application fee.

3. If applicant's native language is not English, an official score on one of the following English proficiency exams is required: SAT-II, ELP, IELTS, Cambridge CAE, Cambridge General Certificate of Education (A and O Levels), Comprehensive English Language Test, Michigan Test of English Language Proficiency, Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).
4. Certification of finances with either:
 1. Certificate from the financial institution where funds have been deposited or where accounts have been maintained by applicant or applicant's sponsor.
 2. Certificate from the applicant or applicant's sponsor attesting to the ability to financially support studies at OLLU.
5. If transferring from a United States college or university applicant must submit:
 1. Proof of immigration status.
 2. An International Student Advisor's Transfer Report on form requested from the Kliesen International Center (210) 434-6711, Ext. 322 or (210) 431-3978.
